

Special Services Cooperative & District Computer Responsibilities
As Approved by Governing Board
May 11th, 2005

Special Services Cooperative will be responsible for providing to all district classroom teachers computer hardware needed to establish and/or maintain a functional computer workstation, including CPU, Monitor, Keyboard, Mouse, Speakers, and Printer. Special Services Cooperative will also replace and/or repair all hardware deemed necessary to keep the computer workstation functional. This would include the replacement and/or repair of any computer hardware items as referred to above and items such as:

- Operating System
- Word Processing Software (Microsoft Office if possible)
- Hard Drives
- CD-ROM Drives
- Memory
- Cables
- Printer Ink Cartridges

The housing district assumes responsibility in providing all other aspects of functional computing. Such as:

- Internet Access and Connectivity to District Network Resources
- Virus Protection
- End-User Support
- Other specialized software and/or specifications required by district policy
